I obtained the median weekly rental price in Darwin for a three-bedroom house which is 480\$ and for one bedroom unit, it is 310\$. The transportation cost in the Northern Territory is also effective as it is the first region in Australia for offering free bus travels to all students. Also, there are frequent buses routed among Darwin and other central regions during peak times as well as on weekends and at night [1].

There are various shopping malls in Northern Territory with retail stores inclusion for the daily groceries along with mandatory day-to-day activities.

The average meal cost in Darwin is AU\$46 per day. It also varies well based on the person's spending habit. The average meal cost is around AU\$18 when dining out and this is for single person. The cost of breakfast is bit cheaper than other meals. The food price in sit-down restaurants are higher than street food prices or fast food prices.

The taxi ride cost in Darwin is significantly higher than public transportation. A person typically spend AU\$15 per person, per day on local transportation in the region [2].



There is a decent tropical region maintained in the Northern Territories with the dry and wet seasons when maintaining the average temperature in the entire year. The Darwin's wet season is mainly characterized from higher humidity, storms and monsoonal rains. The average temperatures typically range from 25 – 32 degrees with humidity level to past 80 percent. The region's average annual rainfall is 1800mm and according to research conducted, January is the wettest month. The beautiful time of the year are the months of January and February.
